A Bag Full of Hope

When there's no food for the weekend, life can be tough. Although often unnoticed, hunger exists in our community and impacts the most vulnerable. Sponsored by the Holland & Hart Foundation of Cheyenne, the Friday Food Bag program places food directly into the hands of those children who need it most.

Each Friday of the school year, the program delivers bags of food to Cheyenne children who are at risk for hunger. With the help of a local nutritionist, the bags are filled with nutritious, non-perishable food items. Local dentists, orthodontists, law firms, churches, businesses and individuals have all contributed to this vital program.

Over the upcoming school year, the program anticipates that it will be able to deliver over 4000 food bags, approximately 130 each week, to all schools in Laramie County School Districts #1 and #2, Head Start, and Safehouse.

Again this year, Friday Food Bag volunteers from Frontier encouraged its Vendor Appreciation Day Committee to name the Friday Food Bag program as its designated charity. Through the generosity of its vendors, contractors and employees, Frontier was able to donate \$9,093.50.
